Outstanding Coach Award Nomination**

PURPOSE:

The Texas A&M University-Commerce Outstanding Coach Award was established in 1994 for the purpose of recognizing outstanding coaches for the dedication, devotion and commitment to the total development of the athlete below the college level. The recipient must have at least one degree from Texas A&M University-Commerce.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Active Category:

Nominee must be employed as a coach below the college level at the time of nomination. Nomination should consider character, integrity, respect of players and community, as well as win-loss record.

2. Emeritus Category:

Nominee must have been employed as a coach below the college level for a minimum of ten years. Nomination should consider tenure devoted to the athlete and the coaching profession, as well as those traits listed in Active category.

3. In Memory of Category:

This category honors the memory of those individual coaches who made a significant contribution to the high school athlete and the coaching professional prior to death.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The selection committee is appointed by the President of the Athletic Association. The committee will review the nominations and make recommendations to the Athletic Association Board of Directors.
