Dr. Travis presented additional clarification to changes to the Doctoral Research Tools for a Ph.D. in English that were approved by the Graduate Council in December. After a discussion, a motion to accept an amendment was made by Dr. Harr and seconded by Dr. Kopachena. The Graduate Council voted unanimously to change Procedure 11.46 Doctoral Research Tools, Section 1.b. to read as follows:

The research tools requirement for the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in English is 12 semester hours of college-level classes in one foreign language.

Students with native or near-native competence in a relevant foreign language may consult with the departmental Director of Graduate Studies regarding this requirement.
