***Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship Criteria:**

Must apply for this scholarship prior to first semester of enrollment at TAMUC. Must have a minimum of 45 transferable hours with a 3.0 G.P.A. Must maintain full-time enrollment (12 credit hours) each semester with a semester and cumulative 3.0 G.P.A.

***Phi Theta Kappa –All State Scholarship Criteria:**

Must apply for this scholarship prior to first semester of enrollment at TAMUC. Must have a minimum of 45 transferable hours with a 3.5 G.P.A. Must maintain full-time enrollment (12 credit hours) each semester with a semester and cumulative 3.5 G.P.A.

* Please include your Phi Theta Kappa and/or Phi Theta Kappa – All State certificate(s) when submitting your Undergraduate Scholarship Application. Applications will not be reviewed for these scholarships, if this information is missing.

Transfer Scholarship Criteria:

Must apply for this scholarship prior to first semester of enrollment at TAMUC. Must have a minimum of 30 transferable hours with a 3.0 G.P.A. Must maintain full-time enrollment (12 credit hours) each semester with a semester and cumulative 3.0 G.P.A.

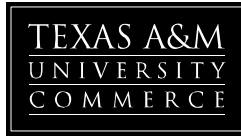

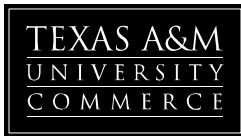
