Meal Plan Agreement and Requirement Policy

Texas A&M University-Commerce meal plan requirement stipulates that all single beginning undergraduate students who are living on campus are required to purchase a University meal plan of at least 10 meals per week. This policy covers all beginning students who are starting college in the same year as their date of graduation from high school. All other residents in University Housing have the option to purchase any meal plan. The student may terminate this agreement during a semester if he/she withdraws or obtains an approved contract release from the Residential Living and Learning office.

Students may make meal plan changes through the 5th (fifth) class day at the Residential Living and Learning office. After the 5th (fifth) class day, students may only increase their meal plan, no decreases will be allowed. No refund is made for missed meals, and meals not eaten are not transferable. The food service director will make every effort to assist the resident who may have a special dietary need. Three meals are served Monday-Friday, brunch and dinner on Saturday and Sunday.

Due to online application processing of meal plans Lion Cash is no longer a mandatory requirement. You may add Lion Cash for any amount to your account during the semester. Lion Cash should be added at the Mane Card Office (903-468-6022) or by credit card through the Mane Card Office Website www.tamu-commerce.edu/lioncard/.

Cancellation of meal plans must be made in writing prior to move in day for Residential Living and Learning each Fall (or Spring if starting in Spring), after that point in time a Contract Release Request will have to be submitted and reviewed by Residential Living and Learning.
