IMPORTANT NOTICE

The University residency requirement stipulates that all single beginning undergraduate students who are not commuting from the home of their parents or legal guardians must reside in University housing (residence halls). This policy covers all beginning students who are starting college in the same year as their date of graduation from high school. Students who have been out of high school for one year or more are exempt from this policy.

Students who graduate early and begin attending the University in the spring semester will be expected to live on campus the next academic year, which would be their regular freshman year, even if they have obtained sophomore status. Students who start college with credits taken while in high school will be expected to complete the academic year contract, regardless if sophomore status is attained at the end of the Fall semester.

I make this application with the understanding that my Housing and Meal Plan contracts will be terminated if acceptance to Texas A&M University-Commerce is denied. If the Housing Application is accepted, I agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of Texas A&M University-Commerce and the Residential Living and Learning.
